

Be respectful. Harassment and abuse are never tolerated. If you are in a situation that makes you uncomfortable at our event, if the event itself is creating an unsafe or inappropriate environment, or if interacting with an event organizer or event staff makes you uncomfortable, please report it to the email below.

Harassment includes but is not limited to offensive verbal or written comments related to gender, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, religion, social class, economic status, veteran status, sexual images, deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of talks or other events, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention. If what you're doing is making someone feel uncomfortable, that counts as harassment and is enough reason to stop doing it.

Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior whatsoever are expected to comply immediately.

If a participant engages in harassing behavior, PsiHacks reserves the right to take any action it deems appropriate, including warnings or expulsion from the event with no eligibility for reimbursement of refund of any type.
